This highly specialised course is aimed at all persons who direct, design or conduct animal research, testing or teaching activities at UCT and in South Africa.

Our main objective is to present the basic principles and facts that underlie the responsible and ethical care and use of non-human animals for scientific purposes.

The majority of lectures and principles included in the course are applicable across animal species. The practical sessions and some of the clinical lectures focus on mice and rats.

The UCT FHS Animal Ethics Committee accredits the course and a certificate will be issued upon successful completion.

The course is accredited by the South African Veterinary Council (SAVC). CPD points will be awarded for courses that are attended by at least five persons who are registered with or authorised by the SAVC.

**Cost:** R 4,950 per person (UCT staff/students are eligible for a discounted rate. Please enquire on application).

**Entry requirements:** Supervisory letter endorsing your participation in animal research and a copy of your ID.
