Information Systems Honours 2021

The Department of Information is offering two one-year bursaries to study towards a BCom Honours degree majoring in Information Systems at the University of Cape Town (includes 4th year B.Bus.Sci students majoring in Information Systems at the University of Cape Town).

In line with the UCT transformation agenda, priority will be given to funding Black South African and Black permanent resident applicants. “Black” includes African, Coloured, and Indian students-

Bursaries will be awarded to the 2 top-performing eligible candidates.

Requirements

The applicant must:

- Be a South African citizen or permanent resident
- Be registered for a B.Com Honours OR be enrolled in 4th year B.Bus.Sci majoring in Information Systems for 2021 (full time)

Duration

- 1 year of full time study

Offer

- The bursary value is ZAR 60,000 for the year

Note:

- Funds will only be disbursed to successful candidates who are registered for the B.Com Honours majoring in Information Systems programme (full time) at the University of Cape Town in 2021 OR are enrolled in 4th year B.Bus.Sci majoring in Information Systems in 2021
- Funds are only to be used towards expenses relevant to the Information Systems Honours programme at UCT
- Successful applicants' who are offered the bursaries by the Department of Information Systems are required to complete and sign the student agreement that will be forwarded at the time of the award.
- The bursary-holder may not hold full-time salaried employment during the tenure of the bursary, however he/she will be allowed to undertake teaching, tutorials, assistance or demonstration duties during the year of study, and he/she may be remunerated for his/her services rendered at the normal university tariff for services.
- The award may be supplemented to the university capped value for the level of study.
- Should the bursary-holder not complete the degree, the total funds received must be returned to the department.
